Can I use power plugs in Zimbabwe?

Select your country of residence, to check the compatibility of your power plugs in Zimbabwe. In Zimbabwe, power plugs and sockets (outlets) of type D and type G are used. The standard voltage is 220 V at a frequency of 50 Hz. For more information, select the country you live in at the top of this page.

Do I need a power adapter in Zimbabwe?

The standard voltage in Zimbabwe is 220-240V, and the frequency is 50Hz. Devices from countries with different voltage standards, like the United States (120V), may require a voltage converter in addition to a plug adapter. Do You Need a Power Adapter in Zimbabwe?

Whether you'll need a power adapter depends on the type of plug your devices use.

Are there electrical outlets in Zimbabwe?

No, the electrical outlets in Zimbabwe are different from those in the United States. In Zimbabwe electrical outlets of types D & G are used, while the United States has electrical outlets of types A & B. Do I need a travel adapter for Zimbabwe?

The electrical outlets and power plugs in Zimbabwe are of types D & G (see images).

What voltage does Zimbabwe use?

Zimbabwe uses outlet types D, G at a voltage of 240V and a frequency of 50 Hz. Plug Compatibility: Type D, Type G Voltage: 240V Frequency: 50 Hz Can North Americans use Electronics in Zimbabwe without an Adapter?

No! North Americans will need an adapter for the outlets and a transformer for the voltage when traveling to Zimbabwe.



What type of plug/socket is used in Zimbabwe?

Check the type of plug/socket used in Zimbabwe. In Zimbabwe, the power plugs and sockets used are of type D and G. Type D has three round pins in a triangular pattern, while Type G has three rectangular pins. Purchase the necessary plug adapters.

Do Europeans need a travel adapter in Zimbabwe?




