What is an international EMS system?

Current international EMS systems have varied features and practices but they all resemble the main models of EMS systems in one way or another. The aim of international EMS systems is to adapt a model that meets the local needs and targets with diverse cultural, political and financial factors of each individual community.

Which countries rely only on BLS services for EMS systems?

Many countries with less funding for public safety rely solely on BLS services for their EMS systems such as much of South Africa, China, and many countries in South and Central America [8,9]. Another distinction of EMS systems internationally is whether a Franco-German model or an Anglo-American model is utilized .

Which countries have a good EMS system?

The very few transported patients are usually directly admitted to hospital wards by the attending field emergency medicine physician bypassing the emergency department. Countries such as Germany, France, Greece, Malta and Austria have well-developed Franco-German EMS systems. 9-13.

Which EMS systems are available in France?

Any of the four appropriate levels of care can be now dispatched in France, either BLS, ALS, single physician, or mobile MICU depending on the emergency call triage . Throughout Europe, many other national EMS systems were established in the 1960s as well.

How do EMS systems differ in developing countries?

Funding and resources matter. In contrast, in many developing countries, EMS systems may be more fragmented and under-resourced. For example, in many parts of Africa and Asia, EMS services may be provided by a mix of

government agencies, non-governmental organizations (NGOs), and private companies.

What is an example of an EMS system?

In many developed countries, EMS systems are highly organized and well-funded. For example, in the United States, EMS is an integrated part of the healthcare system, with a complex network of ambulance services, dispatch centers, and emergency departments.
