How much does an outdoor power supply cost in the Cook Islands





Overview

Do I need a power adapter in Cook Islands?

If your devices are compatible with these specifications, you will not need a power adapter. However, if your devices use a different plug type or are not compatible with the voltage in Cook Islands, you will need a power adapter and/or a voltage converter/transformer.

What voltage does Cook Islands use?

The voltage in Cook Islands is the same as in Europe. However, Europeans will need a travel adapter when traveling to Cook Islands. What Outlet does Cook Islands Use?

Type I plug sockets are used in Australia, New Zealand. They have two flat pins and a grounding pin. These plugs are typically used with devices that have a voltage of 230V.

Can a universal power adapter fit a Cook Islands outlet?

Universal power adapters usually come with multiple plug types and can be adjusted to fit Cook Islands outlets and many others. If your devices are not compatible with the voltage in your destination country, a voltage converter or transformer will also be necessary to convert the voltage to the appropriate range for your devices.

What type of plug does Cook Islands use?

For Cook Islands, there is one associated plug type: type I. Cook Islands operates on a 240V supply voltage and 50Hz. In Cook Islands the power sockets used are of type I. Use the photo below to help identify the right plug and socket. Plug adapters are the interfaces between the American flat-pronged plug and Cook Islands' three flat-prong socket.

Can a North American plug be used in Cook Islands?



North Americans device plugs will not work with the outlet types in Cook Islands. Also, the voltage in Cook Islands is different from North American voltages. Can Europeans use Electronics in Cook Islands without an adapter?

Europeans do not need a transformer when traveling to Cook Islands. The voltage in Cook Islands is the same as in Europe.

Do I need a travel adapter to travel to the Cook Islands?

This plug type is also commonly found in Australia, New Zealand, and other countries in the region. If you are traveling to the Cook Islands with a device that uses a different plug type, you will need to bring a travel adapter. You can purchase travel adapters at most electronics stores or online.


